2014 Exchanges

Members have voted for their preferences for 2014 outbound exchanges. Our members' top choices were Austria, Norway, Turkey and the Ukraine. We'll be advised in early 2013 by FFI Atlanta of the clubs that we will be visiting in 2014.

Canadian FF Conference

The Canadian Conference has been set for Edmonton on September 18, 19 & 20, 2014. The goal is to have 200 conference delegates. Sessions will be held in both French and English.
