#### <u>Inbound</u>

**Piracicaba, Brazil.** The dates for the exchange are July 5 to July 12. We have 28 ambassadors coming, ranging in ages 11 to 80. We are having our first organizational meeting on March 19th. The Friendship Force of Manitoba has agreed to help us with home hosting for this exchange. Friendship Force of Manitoba travelled to Piracicaba several years ago.

<u>Northern Illinois, USA</u>. The dates for this exchange are September 18 to September 24. Jim Kubas is the ED and Carol Frederickson is the Assistant ED.

Members will be asked to volunteer as **Home Hosts**, **Day Hosts** and **Dinner Hosts** for both inbound exchanges. Jim will soon be asking members to volunteer for the Northern Illinois inbound exchange in September as no club meetings are planned during July and August.
