Election of Officers



2013 Exchanges

Northern Illinois, USA - September 18 to September 24. Jim Kubas was the ED and Carol Frederickson was the Assistant ED. We hosted 14 incoming ambassadors; 10 from FF Northern Illinois, 2 from FF Greater Orlando, Florida and 2 from Cedar Rapids, lowa.

A total of 55 club members participated in one or more of the 12 planned activities during the exchange. The average participation per activity was 30 (16 FFW members and 14 ambassadors). The activities were planned to showcase the cultural diversity and history of Winnipeg and environment. Two free days (Saturday and Sunday) were provided to give the ambassadors an opportunity to become better acquainted with their home hosts, and to enjoy and learn more about our part of the world. Two of our home host families hosted ambassadors that they had met on previous exchanges.

Outbound

The dates for this exchange are October 7 to October 21, 2013. There are 21 ambassadors for this exchange: 10 from our club, 5 from FF Manitoba, 5 from other clubs in Canada and 1 from a club in USA. The 2014 Outbound Exchange to Izmir, Turkey is scheduled for one week in April.

We will be hosting two inbound exchanges in 2014. Tentative dates for these exchanges are FF Comitan/FF Filibobos, Mexico in July and FF Saitama, Japan from September 3rd to the 9th.
