2013 Exchanges

Inbound

Piracicaba, Brazil: Our club welcomed 23 ambassadors from July 4th to July 11th after which they left for Milwaukee for another week to complete their North American exchanges.

Joe Keenan was the ED and Gladys Thomas was the Assistant ED. it was a fun week filled with interesting and unique activities. We took in Scheutzenfest in the Little Britain area (near Lockport) which is based on a marksmen shooting event that is traditional in Germany. We had a bus trip to Southern Manitoba where the highlight was a visit to Neuburgthal, a designated historic site, to tour a Mennonite village and its unique housebarns. The farewell banquet was held at the Hunt's Country Roadhouse, north of Petersfield, where one of the highlights was a huge nostalgia collection of 40's, 50's and 60's memorabilia.

Northern Illinois, USA Jim Kubas is the ED and Carol Frederickson is the Assistant ED. The dates for this exchange are September 18 to September 24. We are expecting 14 ambassadors. Activity sign-up sheets will be emailed/sent to members. These should be completed and returned to Jim Kubas no later than September 9th. Sign-up sheets will also be available and collected at our August meeting.

Outbound

Trujillo and Tarapoto, Peru. ED Paul Havixbeck; Assistant ED, Lorraine Franz . The dates for this exchange are October 7 to October 21, 2013. There are 21 ambassadors for this exchange: 10 from our club, 5 from FF Manitoba, 5 from other clubs in Canada and 1 from a club in USA. The exchange will be extended with an optional add-on for visiting Cusco, Machu Picchu, Lake Titicaca and Lima.

2014 Exchanges

The 2014 Outbound Exchange to Izmir, Turkey is scheduled for one week in April.

We will be hosting two inbound exchanges in 2014. Tentative dates for these exchanges are FF Comitan/FF Filibobos, Mexico in July and FF Saitama, Japan in September.

For each of the 2014 exchanges our club will require an Exchange Director and an Assistant Exchange Director. It's not too early to consider becoming actively involved with these exchanges.

2015 Exchanges

The deadline for submitting our requests for our Outbound Exchanges for 2015 is November 1, 2013. Vote for your exchange preference by completing the request forms that have been sent out. Bring them to the August meeting or return them to Paul by September 11.

FFI - World Conferences

The 2013 conference will be from November 22 to November 25, 2013 in New Orleans, USA. About 75 Canadian FF members have registered with several from FFW. This will be the best attended FFI world conference.

The 2014 conference will be held in Auckland, New Zealand form October 14 to 16, 2014 at the Rendezvous Grand Hotel. Registration will begin in early 2014.

The 2015 World Conference has been announced. It is scheduled to take place in Vancouver, Canada from September 11 to 14, 2015
