INFORMATION FROM BOARD MEETING

- 1) A Committee was formed to examine the \$35 fee ambassadors pay on outbound exchanges. The Committee members were Norma W., Norma P., Linda D., Paul V., Susan M. and Marilyn Z. The fee will be reduced to \$25 due to the decrease in administrative costs. This fee will be used for a booklet on the exchange for each ambassador. Excess funds will be used at the discretion of the ambassadors.
- 2) **World Friendship Day** is March 1. However, on **March 8**, our two clubs will celebrate WFD together. Our club will be hosting the dinner at St. Andrews Church on Portage Avenue and FF Manitoba Club will be in charge of the program. **Mark your calendar for March 8**. (More details to follow in the new year.) 2017 is the 40th Anniversary of FF. It started on March 1, 1977 by Wayne Smith & President Jimmy Carter. This is why there is a special cruise that six of our members are going on. 2017 is a big year for Canada's 150th and clubs across the country will be celebrating by having special events.
- 3) Our club has been invited to have a Canadian 150 Year Celebration with the FF Brandon and FF Manitoba clubs. We will receive further information at a later date.
